

2011 Achievement In Brief:

- Reading
70.97% of all students are reading at or above the level expected for their age.
51.66% of all children in Years 4-6 are reading in excess of 12 months above the level expected at their age.
All but 3 Year 6/7 children are reading at expected level.
The percentage of children more than 6 months below has risen sharply but includes a large number of children new to our school.
- STAR Reading
Operating at National Normed stanine expectations.
16 of our lowest 28 children have increased at least 1 stanine this year.
When 'decile adjusted' data shows evidence of strong teaching and learning.
- Spelling
Goal achieved for the first time in many years.
70.25% of all children working at the expected level.
- Writing
90.51% of all children writing at or above the levels expected at their age – highest levels of achievement for at least 6 years.
Maori working at similar levels to non Maori.
Need to reconsider writing benchmarks next year.
- Mathematics (Numeracy)
70.80% of all children working at expected levels for their age.
25.66 Near Expectation.
13.27% of all children working at least one level above that expected at their age.
- PAT Mathematics
Percentage of children in top 4 stanines has increased from 15% to 50% during the year.
Percentage of children in the bottom three stanines reduced from 59% to 16%.
School achieving in line with National expectations.
- Information Literacy
Improved progress in senior school.
Less than expected progress in Years 3-4.
- ICT
Similar results to last year achieved.
- Te Reo Maori
Good progress made, in particular in Year 4.
- Children's School enjoyment and learning review.
93% of children state that they are learning heaps or Quite a lot.
94% of children like school. Average score out of 10 - 9.3.
